Kingston Life Center Incorporation is a vital 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that attempts to moderate the negative impacts of apathy and lack of available outreach services for the underserved population of Alpine, Alabama and beyond. Our organization's projects, implemented by a well-trained staff, offer many opportunities for the reduction of depravity and poverty through needed intervention. Supporting the development of mind, body, and soul, Kingston Life Center Incorporation provides as many individuals as possible with a thorough foundation for future success.

Kingston Life Center, Inc.'s purpose is to provide a life center that makes a positive difference in its community and surrounding area. Our mission is simple: to improve the quality of life for the people we touch through the services and programs we offer.

Through the continuation of our programs, our organization will address the needs of our target communities, brighten lives, and assist each participant achieve their personal goals. Our organization's objectives are accomplished by implementation of stimulating activities and materials that are organized around a well-developed prospectus.

Since inception, our organization has demonstrated our commitment through fervent fundraising to support our human services activities. We have been fortunate to have generated adequate revenue to provide holiday meals to over twenty five needy families. We are currently seeking the funding required to construct a facility that will house all of our outreach services. Our proposed life center will include the following services:

## Meals on Wheels Program

Since inception, Kingston Life Center Incorporation has been operating a meals on wheels program for the elderly and needy individuals that are unable to afford the basic needs required to live a healthy lifestyle or do not have the abilities to leave their home. Throughout this program, participants have the opportunity to receive nutritious meals and develop meaningful relationships with our caring volunteers and staff members. Our trained representatives are available to assist the clients with any additional concerns they may be facing and make referrals to outside community and government programs that may be of assistance.

Kingston Life Center Incorporation's administrators provide breakfast once per month on Saturdays and Mondays, a monthly brunch on Wednesdays, and a monthly dinner on Fridays. Prior to the delivery date, the organization will contact registered individuals to confirm their need for the meal in order

to ensure an accurate headcount. We have successfully recruited a team of representatives that will prepare and deliver the meals to our participants.

## Counseling Programs

Recognizing the needs that exist among our target population, Kingston Life Center Incorporation's staff provides individuals with faith based counseling sessions that focuses on individual empowerment. Interested participants may schedule pastoral counseling appointments with our experienced religious leaders to discuss any life concerns they may be facing. The subjects addressed during these sessions may include, but are not limited to, marriage and family, spiritual growth, and developing healthy communication skills. The length of time spent in the counseling sessions, and number of sessions per client, will vary and is dependent upon their needs and interest. Individuals may also be provided with the contact information of relevant community resources during this time if deemed necessary. Our services are made available to any individual in need, regardless of their ability to pay.



## Educational Services

Kingston Life Center Incorporation is also seeking the funding required to provide a variety of educational classes and job readiness training programs for community members to attend throughout the year. All classes will be available to any youth or adult in the community seeking to develop essential skills that will prepare them for a successful future. Participation is on a first come, first serve basis as venue capacity allows.

Our instructors will provide a variety of program curriculums that are designed to elevate the performance of our participants and to bring them to new heights in their professional and personal achievements. The types of training we provide may include, but are not limited to, GED preparation, ACT/SAT preparation, resume writing, and job preparation classes.

## Senior Citizen Center

Kingston Life Center Incorporation's administrators are in the developmental stages of establishing a center for underserved senior citizens that are unable to locate enriching daytime programs. While attending our programs, every client will have the opportunity to socialize with one another and participate in engaging recreational activities. Seniors will have the option to read a book, browse the internet, join in fitness activities, complete a variety of craft activities, or play recreational games with others. Every client will also be provided with nutritious and hearty meals that have been prepared by our staff members in our meals on wheel programs.

## Youth Work Camp

Kingston Life Center Incorporation is also seeking the funding required to establish a summer work camp for school aged children. Throughout the two week camp, students will have the opportunity to complete small renovations for needy individuals residing in our community. These

renovations may include, but are not limited to, fixing holes in walls, repairing roof shingles, and painting projects. The overall aspiration of our summer camp program is to provide an opportunity for learning, laughter, and service, while helping to create a very enriching summer for all of the individuals participating in our services.

Our activities are overseen by a group of well-qualified individuals. Our diverse staff members have ties to the community, and thus possess the unique ability to relate to the target demographic. Additionally, our Board of Directors is comprised of a professional group of talented individuals who are dedicated to committing their time and resources to building a stronger community.
